



City Centre Development Agency Merchant Lighting Rebate Program

The City Centre Development Agency (CCDA) is offering a new security lighting rebate program to stakeholders. The lighting rebate program will refund CCDA members up to \$400 of back alley lighting installation costs.

1. Objective

To enable leaseholders in the Medicine Hat downtown core to access available funding to add safety and security to their business. This is done by subsidizing the costs associated with installing security lighting at the rear of the business in the back alley/parking lot.

2. Eligible

All leaseholders within the downtown core included in the current Business Improvement Area Assessment Roll. New businesses will be eligible on proof of business license and current lease/title.

3. Grant Limit

Up to \$200 of receipted cost of each light fixture and installation may be refunded, up to 2 lights per business for a maximum total of \$400.

4. Availability

The program will be funded with \$10,000. It will end December 31, 2020 or when funds are expended.

5. Program Timing

The program will run until December 31, 2020, with the option to extend the program if the needs of stakeholders warrant it.

6. Eligibility for Leaseholders

- a. As per section 2 above.
- b. Available on a first come first serve basis.
- c. CCDA members may reserve rebate funding up until December 1. Funding to cover one rebate will be reserved for the member for one month.

7. Eligible Costs

- a. Outdoor light fixtures

Ineligible Costs

- a. Security monitoring services
- b. Indoor lighting
- b. Security cameras

8. General Terms and Information

- a. All interpretation of these rules is under the authority of the CCDA Board.
- b. Rebate paid upon completion of project.
- c. Applications will be accepted at any time and are subject to review by the CCDA Development Committee or Board of Directors at any time.
